"Rock Fishing"

For me, it was a fun hobby. From when we were children. Let's say from when I was around 12 years old, we used to walk, when my father (R.I.P) used to fish with his friends, we used to go rock fishing. We used to go to the rocky part of the island.

We used to go rock fishing around Daimari, Andicuri, what we used to call Piedra Preto which is now known as Conchi. They call it Conchi. We used to fish in all those spots. We used to walk from our neighborhood, back then Siribana, and walk all the way to Daimari. That's a 4 to 5 km stretch. We used to walk to and from there.

Sometime after, my father and his friends used to get rides. But back then, the roads were so bad that we could not go all the way there by car. We used to get there halfway by car and then walk the rest.
